Pursuant to the authority provided under California Government Code Section 68115 and as granted in the June 19, 2020 order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California,

This Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**


The court extends the time period provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony offense must be taken before a magistrate from 48 hours to not more than seven (7) days. (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(8).) This order applies only to

1 defendants for whom the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from June 22, 2020, to July
2 18, 2020, inclusive (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(8)).

3 This order is intended to supplement the statewide orders issued by the Chief Justice of
4 the California Supreme Court and Emergency Rules of Court adopted by Judicial Council of
5 California.
